**Date: October 28, 1935**

**SUBJECT: *Amending Sections 6 and 13 of Fish and Game Administrative Order No. 5 re: closed seasons for certain species of buds and mammals.***

1. Section 6 of Fish and Game Administrative Order No. S dated September 26, 1934 is hereby amended to read as follows.

"6. Other protected birds. - By virtue of the provisions of Section 2 of Act No. 2590, as amended, it shall be unlawful to hunt, take, wound, or kill in any manner or have in possession at any season of the year the following birds, except as herein provided:

*Provided, however,* That herons (candangajo), hawks (lawin), ospreys and eagles, asiatic kingfishers (susulpot), galancias, weavers (mayang pula or mayang paking), house sparrows (mayang bato, mayang simbahan or mayang costa), and crows (uwak) may be destroyed by property owners whenever they become injurious to their property: *Provided. Further,* That cockatoos (catala), lorikeets (culasisi), guaiaberros (bobotok), parakeets and parrots (loro), finches (strawberry finches), weavers (mayang pula or mayang paking), sparrows (mayang bato, mayang simbahan or mayang costa) may be taken in any manner at any season of the year and without license for domestic pets: Provided, also, That any bird taken in accordance with this Section shall not be transported from one island to another without special permit from the Secretary of Agriculture and Commerce or his duly authorized representative." (Sec. 2 and 14 Act No. 2590).

2. Section 13 of Fish and Game Administrative Order No. 5 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"13 **injurious animals.** - Wild pigs may be taken or killed in any manner at any season of the year and without license, and monkeys wild cats and other mammals not mentioned herein may be caught or destroyed by property owners at any time that such animals cause destruction to their property."

3. **Date of effectivity.** - This Order shall take effect on January 30, 1936.
