<b>Remarks/Market Observations:</b>		<p><b>The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The price of Bangus had an increased at a price of Php160.00/kg last Jan 5, 2021 due to lesser unloaded supply at Navotas Fish Port. Also, the low supply for marine commodities resulted to a higher demand for aquaculture fishes which resulted to its higher price. The price then stabilize at Php140.00/kg on the latter part of the week due to the more unloadings plus the availability of marine commodities at Navotas Fish Port.</li> <li>Less supplies for local galunggong and Alumahan were observed at Navotas Fish Port throughout the month due to the effects of the closed fishing season (CFS) for pelagic fishes in Northeastern Palawan and Visayan Sea, which are major fishing grounds for galunggong and alumahan. The occurrence of northeast moonsoon which causes the colder weather also contributed to the low catch as fishes tend to stay at the bottom of the sea making it harder for the fishermen to catch them.</li> <li>Supplies for imported galunggong increased as more unloadings at Navotas Fish Port were observed this week.</li> <li>Lesser volume of unloadings for Tilapia were observed at Navotas Fish Port last 5 January 2021 resulting to a higher price at Php100.00/kg. The price then sustained at Php90.00/kg as more supply were unloaded on 8 January 2021.</li> <li>Marine commodities like Tahong (Php100.00/kg), Gulyasan (Php85.00/kg), Tamban (Php30.00/kg), Tangigue (Php350.00/kg), Dalagang Bukid Bilog(Php150.00/kg) and Pusit Bisaya (Php250.00/kg) have supplies at Navotas Fish Port but were not reflected as prevailing prices as only 1-2 vendors were observed selling and is reflected as actual price only.</li> <li>Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Bangus - Pangasinan</li> <li>Tilapia - Batangas</li> <li>Local-Fresh Galunggong - NA</li> </ol> </li> <li>Precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 such as but not limited to wearing of face masks and face shields, limiting of buyers entering the market at a time, and mandatory temperature checks are still continuously being observed by consumers and vendors in the monitored wholesale market.</li> </ol>
