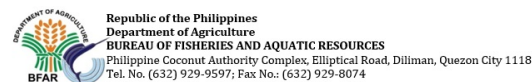

**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:**

- Fresh marine commodities, particularly medium-sized Local-fresh galunggong and Alumahan, have no unloading at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. The limited availability of the said commodities may be attributed to the cold weather condition brought by the Northeast Moonsoon or "Hanging Habagat." However, supplies of Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan are expected to increase in the coming days with the recent lifting of the Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for pelagic fishes in Northeastern Palawan last Jan. 31, as well as the upcoming lifting of CFS for sardines, herrings, and mackerels in Visayan Sea on Feb. 15.
- Meanwhile, supplies of aquaculture commodities such as Bangus and Tilapia continue to be sufficient, resulting to the steady wholesale prices this week.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong still has ample displays at the fish port, resulting to the sustained prevailing wholesale prices this week.
- Other fresh marine commodities, such as Galunggong "Lalake," Imelda, Gulyasan, Tamban, Bisugo, Pusit Bisaya, Labahita, Sapsap, Galunggong "babae", Talakitok and Espada were noted at Navotas Fish Port but in limited volumes only.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follows:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
- At Navotas Fish Port, the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority is continuously implementing precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 such as, but not limited to, wearing of face masks and face shields, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
