Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- The occurrence of full moon or "Snow Moon" last February 28 and the cold weather condition brought by the Northeast Monsoon or "Hanging Amihan" have adversely affected the fish catch in major fishing grounds. More specifically, no medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) at the early part of the week as majority of the unloaded supplies are small-sized. In addition to the above-mentioned factors, the smaller sizes of fishes caught may have also been caused by the recent lifting of Closed Fishing Season in major fishing grounds, wherein fishes are mostly not mature in terms of size.
- Wholesale price of Imported-frozen Galunggong "lalaki" (*Decapterus macrosoma*) was relatively stable this week as supplies at Navotas Fish Port was reported to be steady. However, less Imported-frozen Galunggong "babae" (*Decapterus ruselli*) were noted at the fish port this week, resulting to the relatively higher selling price.
- Both wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia were unchanged this week due to the stable and sufficient supplies at Navotas Fish Port.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follows:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to implement precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in Navotas Fish Port. Among these measures are wearing of face masks and face shields plus white shirt and white boots and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
