Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of March:

1. Abundant supplies of fresh marine commodities, including small and medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong, were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this month.
2. With the abundance of its local variant, lesser volumes of Imported-frozen Galunggong were noted this month with prevailing prices depending on the availability of fresh marine commodities.
3. Sufficient supplies of aquacultured commodities like Bangus, Tilapia, and Hipon were observed at Navotas Fish Port this month. Minimal price changes were noted depending on the source area, size, and total volume of unloaded supplies.
4. Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follows:
 - a. Bangus - Pangasinan
 - b. Tilapia - Batangas
 - c. Imported-frozen Galunggong - China, Vietnam
5. Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to implement precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the ECQ (April 1-11) and MECQ (April 12-30) in NCR Plus (inc. Bulacan, Rizal, and Laguna). Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks, face shields, white shirt, and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
