Remarks/Market Observations	<p>The following observations were gathered from market vendors and administrators for the month of June:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Sufficient volumes and displays of fresh marine commodities were noted in the monitored retail markets this month. On the other hand, lesser volume of displays were noted on the first week due to hampered fishing operations caused by the unfavorable weather condition brought by typhoon dante and fourth week due to bad weather condition brought by the southwest monsoon and the occurrence of "Pink Moon" or fullmoon on June 25. For medium sized local-fresh galunggong, the prevailing retail price was recorded at Php180.00/kg due to sufficient availability of commodity in the entire month. Relative to the ample volume of its local-fresh variant, no Imported-frozen Galunggong were noted in the monitored markets in the entire month. For medium size alumahan, unstable and limited supply were recorded this month in selected monitored retail markets at varying retail prices. The differences in prices may have been caused by variations in source areas and quality of available supplies. Meanwhile, the prevailing retail price of bangus and tilapia remained stable due to sufficient and steady supplies in the monitored retail markets. Top fishery commodities in the sixteen (18) monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Bangus - Bulacan Tilapia - Batangas Local Galunggong - Navotas Fish Port (Palawan) & Lucena, Quezon Imported Galunggong - NA Alumahan - Malabon Fish Port Fluctuations in the prices of the top fifteen (15) and other commodities are influenced by a number of factors such as the commodity's size, quality, volume of supply, source area, as well as the weather condition and other natural phenomena. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *<i>Scylla serrata</i> or Alimango (Php450 - Php900/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php450.00/kg was recorded in Malabon Central where supplies were relatively smaller in size; thus, sold at a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php900.00/kg was noted in Guadalupe Market where supplies were larger in size. *<i>Epinephelus sp.</i> or Lapu-lapu (Php320 - Php500/kg)- lowest prevailing price of Php320.00/kg was recorded in Galas market where supplies were relatively smaller in size; thus, were sold at a lower price. Highest prevailing price of Php500.00/kg was noted in Guadalupe Market where supplies were reported to be in larger size. *<i>Caranx sp.</i> or Talakitok (Php300 - Php450/kg)- Lowest prevailing price of Php300.00/kg was recorded in Commonwealth and Mega-Q Market and Maypajo Caloocan where supplies are noted to be in smaller sizes as compared with the available supplies in Farmers and Guadalupe Market which are reportedly larger in size having the highest prevailing price of Php450.00/kg. *<i>Mene maculata</i> or Chabeta/Hiwas (Php140/kg - Php340/kg) - lowest prevailing price of Php140.00/kg was recorded at Balintawak Market where supply are in low quality as supplies are from previous market days. Highest prevailing price were noted at Guadalupe Market where supplies were of good quality. Further, Guadalupe Market is a secondary market that sources from Farmers Market; hence, the higher selling price. *<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i> or Galunggong "Lalake"- Small-sized (Php100 - Php200/kg) -lowest prevailing price of Php100.00/kg for Galunggong "lalake" was recorded at Maypajo and Balintawak Markets, which are primary or "bagsakan" type of markets. Highest prevailing price of Php200.00/kg was noted in Guadalupe and Marikina Markets, which are secondary markets; hence, offer fishes at higher price ranges. Low demand of fishery commodities continued to be apparent throughout the monitored retail markets. To cope with this, vendors are opted to limit the volume and variety of fish supplies for selling to avoid spoilage of displays or opt not to open on a daily basis. Meanwhile, some vendors are not opening their stalls daily, continued to sell on an alternate-day schedule or open during weekends only, or lower their selling price just for them to sell. Precautionary safety measures are continuously implemented in the monitored markets to safeguard vendors and consumers against COVID-19. These measures include wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, observance of physical distancing, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
