Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors for the month of May:

- Aquacultured commodities, particularly Tilapia and Bangus, were noted to have sufficient availability from major source areas on May Week 1. Variations in the prices of the said commodities vary greatly depending on the size and volume of unloadings.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Imported-frozen Galunggong - China, Vietnam
- As the COVID-19 pandemic remain in place, the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to ensure the implementation of precautionary safety measures (eg., wearing of face masks and face shields as well as white shirt and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) to avoid further spread of the virus at Navotas Fish Port.
- No wholesale price data, volume, and market observations on the unloadings of fresh fishery commodities were provided by PFDA from May Week 2 to Week 4 as the Bureau is still awaiting on the updates from the PFDA regarding their efforts to centralize its database on wholesale prices of unloaded fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port Complex.
