**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

1. Large volumes of fresh marine commodities, particularly Gulyasan and Tamban, were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
2. However, Local-fresh Galunggong was not available at the fish port throughout the week. Relative to this, Imported-frozen Galunggong was offered as an alternative to its local variant.
3. Aquacultured commodities (especially Bangus, Tilapia, and Hipon) were noted to have sufficient availability in the fish port. Majority of the available Bangus are medium- to large-sized.
4. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - a. Bangus - Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - b. Tilapia - Batangas
  - c. Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
5. Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields, mandatory temperature checks, wearing of white boots and white shirts) measures are continuously implemented at the Navotas Fish Port Complex by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to protect the vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
