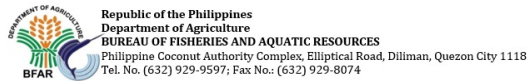

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- One (1) fishing vessel unloaded Local-fresh Galunggong at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. The said vessel from Northern Palawan has unloaded 1,815 tubs of Local-fresh Galunggong which is relatively higher compared to the unloading last week where fish catch were adversely affected by the occurrence of Super Full Moon.
- Besides Galunggong, large volumes of other fresh marine such as Tahong, Gulyasan, Tamban, Matambaka, and Dalagang Bukid were also available at the fish port.
- With the ample availability of fresh marine commodities, smaller volumes of Imported-frozen Galunggong were noted at Navotas Fish Port this week. In addition, the imported commodity's wholesale price is highly dependent on the supply and prices of fresh marine commodities.
- For Bangus and Tilapia, sufficient volumes of the commodities remain available at Navotas Fish Port with varying prevailing prices depending on the sizes and total volume of unloaded supplies.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are as follows:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Palawan
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues to implement precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 in accordance with the Enhanced Community Quarantine in NCR Plus (inc. Bulacan, Rizal and Laguna) until Apr. 11. Among these measures are mandatory wearing of face masks, face shields, white shirt, and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection.
