Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Ample unloadings of fresh marine commodities such Pusit, Dalagang Bukid, Gulyasan, Matambaka, Tamban, and Tulingan were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong, on the other hand, was noted to have lower availability at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week amid the sufficient availability of its local-fresh variant, which is usually more preferred by consumers.
- Bangus and Tilapia continue to have sufficient unloadings and stable prices in the wholesale market. Further, it was noted that majority of the available Bangus at the fish port are medium to large-sized from Pangasinan.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus -Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) is continuously implementing precautionary measures in accordance with the Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) such as wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white shirts and white boots, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection, to protect vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
