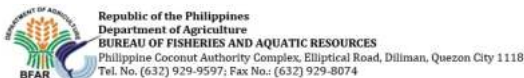

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- Abundant volumes of medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong male variant (*Decapterus macrosoma*) were noted at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week. More specifically, a total of 5,770 tubs of the said commodity from Northern Palawan and Zamboanga were unloaded by Three (3) companies on April 20 & 23, 2021.
- Similarly, large volumes of other fresh marine commodities such as Gulyasan, Hipon, Dalagang Bukid, Tamban, and Local-fresh Galunggong female variant (*Decapterus russelli*) were also unloaded at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- With the abundance of its local variant, lower volumes of Imported-frozen Galunggong were available at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) this week.
- Bangus, Tilapia, and other aquacultured commodities were noted to have sufficient volumes and stable prices at Navotas Fish Port amid the ample unloadings from major source areas. Minimal price changes were noted depending on the source area, size, and total volume of unloaded supplies.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) are as follows:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan, Bulacan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Northern Palawan, Zamboanga
- Precautionary safety measures like mandatory wearing of face masks, face shields, white shirt, and white boots; and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection are still being implemented to prevent the spread of COVID-19 in the market vicinity.
