**Remarks/Market Observations:**

**The following observations were gathered from market personnel:**

- Generally unloadings of fresh marine commodities at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) remain sufficient. For medium-sized Local-fresh Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*), the prices this week are noted to be at a wide price range due to variations in source areas of unloaded supplies.
- Despite the availability of its local-fresh variant, Imported-frozen Galunggong Lalaki (*Decapterus macrosoma*) and female variant (*Decapterus russelli*) remain available in the fish port.
- Meanwhile, wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remain stable due to its steady supply and demand. Most supplies of Bangus from Pangasinan were reportedly bigger in size at 2-3 pcs/kg.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Laguna, Bulacan, Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Local galunggong- South Palawan
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Precautionary measures (e.g., wearing of face mask and face shields as well as white boots and shirts, mandatory temperature checks, and regularly scheduled cleaning and disinfection) are continuously implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port Complex to safeguard vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
