SUBJECT: **Guidelines in the Disposition and Sale of Surplus Milkfish Eggs and Newly-hatched or Day-old Larvae Produced from BFAR Regional Hatcheries, and the National Integrated Fisheries Technology Development Center (NIFTDC)**


In order to standardize the disposition and sale of surplus milkfish eggs, and newly-hatched/day-old larvae produced from BFAR Regional Hatcheries and the NIFTDC, the following operational procedure shall be followed:

1. Information must be disseminated to potential interested parties (e.g. State Universities and Colleges (SUCs), cooperators, fish farmers, other members of the private sector), of the availability and quantity of surplus eggs and / or newly hatched day-old larvae;
2. In the absence of interested parties, the BFAR hatcheries shall allocate at least 50% of the eggs or larvae produced per run, for release to their natural environment (mangroves) as part of BFAR's social and environmental responsibility through a natural re-stocking, resource rehabilitation and enhancement program.
3. The Updated selling prices shall be as follows:

Milkfish Eggs and Larvae	Updated selling Prices
One million Fertilized Eggs	Php 1,000.00
One million Day-old Larvae	Php 2,000.00

4. All expenses relative to the handling, pick-up /transport, and other related operations shall be shouldered by the buyer(s);
5. Milkfish eggs and or larvae shall be picked up from the BFAR hatchery by the buyer(s);
6. Mortalities resulting from the transport and handling of the eggs / larvae shall be the sole responsibility of the buyer(s);
7. BFAR hatchery staff shall monitor production and survival rates of the subject milkfish fry and or larvae after 18 to 21 days rearing period at the buyer's fish farm;
8. Documentation of disposition and sale of the subject milkfish fry and or larvae shall be acknowledged and duly recorded in a prescribed Form attached as Annex A.
