WHAT IS A "FOOD PASS"?



- A "Food Pass" is a privilege given to suppliers and truckers that go to, from, and/or pass through Metro-Manila and other regions during the enhanced community quarantine period to ensure unhampered movement of all cargoes, agriculture and fishery inputs, food products, and agribusiness personnel nationwide
- It is valid within the effectivity period of the enhanced community quarantine.



FOOD PASS APPLICANTS' GUIDE

WHAT TYPES OF VEHICLES MAY SECURE A "FOOD PASS"?



All types of delivery vehicles such as trucks, delivery vans, pick-ups, jeepneys, AUVs/MPVs are allowed.



For light vehicles such as pick-up trucks and AUVs/MPVs, only a maximum of two passengers (1 driver and 1 helper) shall be allowed.

WHAT ARE THE BASIC APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS OF THE "FOOD PASS"?



- Scanned copy of Official Receipt of Registration
- Scanned copy of Certificate of Registration
- Duly accomplished Food Pass Accreditation Application Form
- Duly accomplished Food Pass Reference Form
- Duly accomplished Statement of Commitment
- In case of livestock, poultry and by-products, scanned copy of handler's license and accreditation of transport carriers issued by the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) and accreditation of meat transport vehicle issued by the National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS)



*Only applications with complete submitted application requirements will be processed.

HOW CAN ONE APPLY FOR A "FOOD PASS"?



- Online application is encouraged to minimize interpersonal contacts during the enhanced community quarantine.
- Applicants may apply through: <http://agribusiness.da.gov.ph>.
- If the applicant wishes to apply "in person", the applicant can go to any of the following offices:
 - DA Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service for business permits issued in National Capital Region (NCR);
 - RFO-Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Divisions for business permits issued outside NCR; or
 - any of the following agencies: Philippine Fisheries Development Authority, Bureau of Animal Industry, Sugar Regulatory Authority, National Meat Inspection Service, and Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, whichever is applicable

DA UNIT C	COMMODITIES/PRODUCTS DELIVERED BY APPLICANT
BAI	Live animals (livestock and poultry), feeds and feed ingredients, veterinary products
BFAR	Fish and fishery products
NMIS	Meat and meat products
AMAS	All other commodities, business permits issued in Metro-Manila
RFOAMAD	All other commodities, business permits issued in their respective region

*For online applicants, the "food pass" may be picked-up at the DA offices or sent through a courier of the applicant's choice but at the applicant's expense. If not possible, the applicant may print their pdf copy of the "food pass" sent thru their email address.

FOOD PASS APPLICANTS' GUIDE

WHO CAN APPLY FOR A "FOOD PASS"?



- Single proprietors, cooperatives, associations, companies
 - Registered with DTI, CDA, DOLE, or SEC
 - With business permits (mayor's permits) on supply and/or delivery of rice, perishable agricultural commodities such as fresh fruits and vegetables, livestock and poultry, frozen meat and processed food products, feeds, fertilizers and other agricultural inputs and fishery commodities.
 - *(For poultry and by-products)* must have the handler's license and accreditation of transport carriers from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) and accreditation of meat transport vehicle issued by National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS)
