## SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT / PRIVILEGES

School Fees: FREE Tuition and other school fees or as required by the curriculum except for dormitory fee/rental;

Monthly stipend : Php 4,000.00

Book Allowance : Php 2,000.00 outright grant for textbooks and other essential school supplies release every semester;

Thesis/Special Problem (or its equivalent) Support : Php 7,000.00 outright grant per scholar upon submission of Certified True Copy of thesis proposal and approval sheet;

Graduation Support : Php 1,500.00 per scholar.



## FOR FISHERIES INDUSTRY LEADERS (FIL)

1. Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen and single;
2. A graduating High School student of the current year, not more than 25 years old, and belongs to the TOP TEN of his/her graduating class (not upper 10%), duly certified by the school head/principal; or
3. Any High School graduate, not more than 25 years old, who has not earned any units in college, and belongs to the TOP TEN of his/her graduating class duly certified by the school head/principal;
4. Of good moral character as certified by the school head/principal; and
5. Parent(s)/guardian must be a resident of the municipality for atleast six (6) months.

### CHECKLIST OF DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

- Duly accomplished and signed FSP Application Form for the FILG(Annex 2);
- Original or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate (issued either by PSA or Civil Registrar);
- Certified True Copy of Report Card Form 138 or 137 ((GWA of last 3 semesters of Senior High School is at least 80%);
- Certification from the school head that the applicant belongs to the TOP TEN of the graduating class;
- Certification of good moral character from the school registrar;
- Two (2) recent 2x2 pictures taken within the last three (3) months prior to filing of application; colored with white background;
- Barangay Residence Certificate.

## FOR FISHERFOLK CHILDREN EDUCATIONAL GRANT (FCEG)

1. Must be a natural-born Filipino citizen;
2. Any High School graduate or High School graduating student who is a legitimate and acknowledged illegitimate or legally-adopted child of a registered municipal fisherfolk;
3. Not more than 25 years old;
4. For High School graduate applicants, he/she must not be presently enrolled in college;
5. Of good moral character as certified by the school head/principal; and
6. Parent(s)/guardian must be a registered municipal fisherfolk duly certified by the MAO or BFAR Regional Office in his/her area and should be a resident of the municipality for atleast six (6) months.

### CHECKLIST OF DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS

- Duly accomplished and signed FSP Application Form for the FCEG ;
- Original or Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate (issued either by PSA or Civil Registrar);
- Certified True Copy of Report Card Form 138 or 137 (GWA of last 3 sems of Senior High School is at least 80%);
- Certification of good moral character from the school registrar;
- Photocopy of Fish-R/Mangingsidang Juan ID or Certificate of Registration of parent(s)/guardian (issued by the MAO or BFAR);
- Two (2) recent 2x2 pictures taken within the last three (3) months prior to filing of application; colored with white background;
- Barangay Residence Certificate of the parent(s)/guardian;
- In case of guardianship, affidavit executed by the guardian attesting that the applicant is his/her ward for at least five (5) years.
