Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The fifth year of the implementation of Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for local Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>) in the Northern part of Palawan, pursuant to DA-DILG Joint Administrative Order (JAO) No. 01 series of 2015, ended last 31 January 2020 (Friday), with the resumption of commercial fishing activity beginning 1 February 2020. (Source: Press Release by BFAR RFO-4B, dated 31 Jan. 2020)</p> <p>The following observations were gathered during the actual price monitoring activities this week (January 27-31, 2020):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *A large supply of marine fishes, including "Tamban" (<i>Sardinella lemuru</i>), Alumahan (<i>Rastrelliger kanagurta</i>), Tulingan (<i>Auxis rochei</i>), Pusit (<i>Loligo spp.</i>), and local Galunggong, was available at the fish port due to the large volume of unloading. *The supply of marine fishes continue to be affected by the cold weather brought by the Northeast wind "Hanging Amihan" and the implementation of CFS for other marine species (i.e., <i>Sardines</i>) in some of the major fishing grounds in the country. *There are already Tilapia Batangas at the markets. However, the supply of Tilapia remain lower as compared to that observed prior to the Taal Volcano eruption. *Bangus had a small price increment in January 27 due to the unavailability of supply from Batangas. The price and supply went back to normal the next monitoring day (January 30). The increase in supply of marine fishes caused a lower demand for Bangus, urging some vendors to decrease their selling price. * A large supply of frozen/imported commodities are available at the Navotas Fish Port, majority of which are Squid, Salmon Head, and Galunggong.
