SUBJECT: Amending Section 23 of Fisheries (Fish and Game) Administrative Order No. 2, and for other purposes.

l. Section 23 of Fisheries (Fish and Game) Administra tive Order No. 2 (s. 1933), is hereby amended to read as follows:

"23. Fee for fish caught. The fee for fish caught shall be at the rate of two pesos (P2.00) per metric ton (1,000 kilograms) gross weight. It shall be the duty of every person engaged in commercial fishing to make and submit to the Chief, Division of Fisheries, Department of Agriculture and Commerce or the nearest deputy provincial treasurer a true and complete return of his catch made during the month within the first ten days of the month following that for which the return is made and pay the fee due thereon. The return shall be made in triplicate on (F. G. A.) Form No. 7a to be secured from the Division of Fisheries (Fish and Game Administration) or deputy provincial treasurer. After it is duly sworn to, the deputy provincial treasurer shall collect from the licensee or his agent the amount of fees prescribed in this paragraph and shall issue a receipt therefor on General Form No. 13-A. The duplicate copy of the return shall be kept by the deputy Provincial Treasurer, the original shall be forwarded to the Collector of Internal Revenue and the triplicate to the Chief, Division of Fisheries, Department of Agriculture and Commerce. The number and date of the receipt issued and the amount collected shall be clearly indicated on all copies of the return,

If the fee on fish caught is not paid within the time prescribed above the amount of the fee shall be P4.00 per metric ton gross weight."

2. Effectivity: This Administrative Order shall take effect on January 1, 1946.
