SUBJECT: Amending Sections 1, 2 and 3 of
FAO No. 30 regulating the use of "Kalad-
kad" for gathering snails in Laguna Lake


SECTION 1.- Sections 1, 2 and 3 of Fisheries Administrative
Order No. 30 are hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 1.- It shall be unlawful for any person,
association or corporation to collect or gather snails
by means of "kaladkad" in Laguna Lake from five o'clock
postmeridian to twelve o'clock midnight.


"Sec. 2.- It shall be likewise unlawful for any
person, association or corporation to gather or collect
clams and/or snails in Laguna Lake area by means of "ka-
ladkad" within one hundred meters from any fish corral
authorized by a municipality. All fish corral operators
shall install necessary markers around the 100-meter
periphery of the fish traps.

"Sec. 3.- Pante, kitang and other drift fishing
gear shall be provided with red lights during night time
and flag buoys during day time, placed at visible angles
thereof."

SEC. 2.- This Order shall take effect upon its approval by
the Secretary of Agriculture and Natural Resources.
