ORDER NO. 47 )

SUBJECT: Prohibiting during five (5) years  
the operation of fishing vessels, more  
than three tons gross, in certain portion  
of Tayabas Bay, known as Mogpog Pass, and  
for other purposes.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article III of the Fisheries Act, and for the protection and conservation of certain demersal and pelagic fishes in certain area of Tayabas Bay, the following regulation is hereby promulgated for the information and compliance of all concerned:

1. Prohibition.- It shall be unlawful for any person, association or corporation to operate fishing boats of more than three tons gross, in that portion of Tayabas Bay, between the provinces of Marinduque and Quezon, otherwise known as the Mogpog Pass, during the period of five (5) years.
2. Penalty.- Any violation of this Administrative Order shall subject the offender to prosecution, and upon conviction, shall be punished with the penalty imposed by Section 83 of the Fisheries Act, which is a fine of not more than two hundred pesos or imprisonment for not more than six months, or both, in the discretion of the court.
3. Effectivity.- This Administrative Order shall be in full force and effect during five (5) consecutive years, beginning the date of its approval.
