SUBJECT: Further amending Fish and Game Administrative Order No. 2 by adding another Section, to be known as Section 6-C.

Section 1. - Section 6-C is hereby inserted between Section 6-B and Section 7 of Fish and Game Administrative Order No. 2, as amended, to read as follows:

"Section 6-C. - Lease or sub-lease of licensed commercial fishing beats. The lease or sublease of a licensed commercial fishing boat mere than three (3) tens gress, by a registered ewner and/or lesseeoperator to a qualified party under the Fisheries Act, may be permitted, PROVIDED, that both the lesser and lessee or the sub-lesser or sub-lessee, are jointly and severally liable for any violation of the Fisheries Law, as amended, and of the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, committed, in connection with the operation of said fishing boat during the period of the lease; PROVIDED FURTHER. that the registered owner and/or lessee operator shall not sell, transfer, convey, exchange, sublease, or dispose of, in any manner whatseever, the fishing beat without a written netification to the Director of Fisheries who shall register such sale, transfer, conveyance or disposition in a Registry Book provided for the purpose."

Section 2. - This Order shall take effect upon its premulgation.
