1. Section 3 of Fish and Game Administrative
Order No. 7 is hereby amended to read as
follows:

fry, or eggs, the same shall be presented
by the exporter to the Philippine Fisheries
Commission (Fish and Game Administration,
Bureau of Science). for inspection and

Inspection of fish or aquatic animals exported. - Before exportation of any fish, fry, or eggs, the same shall be presented by the exporter to the Philippine Fisheries Commission (Fish and Game Administration, Bureau of Science), for inspection and such other action as may be necessary, together with a copy of the exporter's declaration properly accomplished. NO FISH, FRY, OR EGGS SHALL BE ALLOWED TO BE LOADED ON BOARD ANY BOAT OR PLANE BY THE CUSTOMS AUTHORITIES, UNLESS THE EXPORTATION IS COVERED BY A SPECIAL PERMIT REQUIRED IN SECTION 2 HEREOF. A FEE EQUIVALENT TO FOUR PER CENTUM OF THE DECLARED VALUE OF THE EXPORTATION SHALL BE CHARGED TO COVER INSPECTION AND PROPHYLACTIC TREATMENT BUT SUCH FEE SHALL IN NO CASE BE LESS THAN ONE PESO (F1.00).

2. This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately upon its approval.
