SUBJECT: Amending Section 1 of Fisheries Administrative Order No. 173, s.

Administrative Order No. 173, s. 1991, re: Banning the exportation of bangus fingerlings (hatirin).

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Fisheries Administrative Order No. 173 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. <u>Definition</u>. - Bangus fingerlings, scientifically known as <u>Chanos chanos</u> (Forskal) and commonly known in the dialect as "hatirin", refer to the young milkfish measuring not less than twenty-five (25) millimeters but not more than one hundred (100) millimeters, are covered by scales and which have been grown for some time in the bangus nursery pond."

SEC. 2. Effectivity. - This Order shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette and/or in two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
