Amending Fisheries General Memorandum Order No. OOl-A, series of 2012 on the Pre and Post Border Requirements in the Application of SPS Clearance for Importation of Fish and Fishery Products and the Lifting of the Prohibition on the Importation of Cherry Salmon, Sand Lance, Japanese Dace and Ayu from Fukushima, Japan

In view of the significant improvements on food safety in fish and fishery products after the nuclear crisis in Japan, the ban on the importation of the following fish species, to wit: Cherry Salmon, Sand Lance, Japanese Dace and Ayu from Fukushima, Japan is hereby lifted specifically the prohibition on the importation thereof under Item 3 of FGMO No. 001-A, series of 2012, "Amending Fisheries General Memorandum Order No. 001, series of 2011 on the Pre and Post Border Requirements in the Application of SPS Clearance for Importation of Fish/ Fishery Products from Japan." The other requirements of FGMO No.001 and FGMO No.001-A, shall remain effective and shall be complied with.

This Memorandum Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in force unless earlier revoked.
