Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>"The Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) regional office in Calabarzon reported on Tuesday that the fish kill phenomenon in Taal Lake is due to an upwelling of sulfur triggered by the strong northeastern winds that accompany an extreme temperature drop in the volcanic lake." Saul Pa-a,(2019),Taal Lake fish kill due to sulfur upwelling: BFAR, from http://www.pna.gov.ph/articles/1060579</p> <p>*Despite the recent news on the Taal Lake fish kill, the wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remained at Php110/kg and Php 80/kg, respectively. *As per the feedback of enumerators, most of the Galunggong sold at the wholesale market are imported and are mostly from China and Vietnam). *Most of the Tilapia supply unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port (Market 1 & 2) are from Batangas. *Generally, marine fish price is high at this time due to the cold weather for which the catch is usually low and difficult because fish tend to stay at the bottom. *DA-BFAR has lifted the closed season for Galunggong in Northeastern Palawan, with resumption of commercial fishing activities starting Feb. 1, 2019.
