Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*The prevailing wholesale price of medium-sized Bangus has been in an increasing trend from Php110.00/kg (September 23 to 27), to Php115.00/kg (September 30-October 4), to Php120.00/kg &amp; Php125.00/kg this week (October 7-11). According to interviews, the increasing trend may be attributed to the decrease in the supply coming from major source areas such as Pangasinan, Bulacan, and Rizal. According to brokers/traders, the low supply is caused by delays in the harvest due to the relatively smaller size of Bangus, alongside their effort to increase the size and value of the commodity in preparation of the upcoming Christmas holidays.</p> <p>*Meanwhile, the supply of marine fishes, including local Galunggong "lalaki" (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), is low this week due to (1) the upcoming full moon on October 14, where the bright moon light causes marine fishes to scatter, making them difficult to catch, and (2) the lean season for some marine fishery commodities. It was also observed that there is still a high number of brokers/traders selling frozen/imported Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>) and other marine fishery commodities at the Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>*As for Tilapia, the price and supply of the said commodity are stable for the whole week.</p> <p>*According to some brokers/traders, the higher wholesale prices of some fishery commodities might be attributed to the nearing of Christmas holidays.</p>
