Remarks/Market Observations:			<p>*The supply of some marine fishes, including local Galunggong "lalaki" (Decapterus macrossoma), remain low in all the monitored retail markets due to (1) the cold weather, where marine fishes tends to stay at the bottom of the ocean that contributed to the low volume of catch, (2) the occurrence of full moon last October 14, where the bright moon light causes marine fishes to scatter making them difficult to catch, (3) the lean season for some marine fishes. In addition, it was observed that some vendors lessened their supply for selling due to the higher wholesale price among some wholesale suppliers alongside the low demand from the buying public (i.e., matamal ang bentahan).</p> <p>**The low supply for local Galunggong "lalaki" and other marine fishes also urged some retail vendors to (1) increase their prices, and (2) for some to sell frozen/imported fishery commodities (e.g., Axiis spp., Decapterus spp.).</p> <p>**There is an observed abundant supply of other species of Galunggong like "Balsa" (Decapterus macarellus), and "Baae" (Decapterus russelli) being sold in some of the monitored markets.</p> <p>*It was observed that there is a lesser supply of seaweeds in some of the monitored market.</p> <p>*As for Bangus, majority of the monitored markets have lower supply except at the Trabajo, Quinta, Farmers, and Muñoz Markets where there is stable supply. According to interviews, this is due to the low supply coming from major source areas such as Pangasian and Bulacan due to some producers extending the culture period of their Bangus in an effort to increase the size and value in preparation for the upcoming Christmas holidays. On the other hand, some retail vendors were observed to sell their supply at higher price despite the stable supply due to higher wholesale price from their respective suppliers.</p> <p>*On the other hand, the price and supply of Tilapia remain stable in all the monitored markets due to the adequate supply coming from Batangas and Pampanga.</p> <p>*Some vendors from Muñoz, Commonwealth, Kamuning, and Quinta Markets noted that the demand for fishery commodities remain low, urging them to lower their selling price (i.e., bagsak presyo) just to get back their capital.</p> <p>*Some markets vendors are selling live Tilapia at Php20.00/kg higher than fresh chilled Tilapia.</p> <p>*Bangus, Tilapia, and local Galunggong are being sold in mixed sizes in some of the monitored retail markets.</p> <p>*The prevailing retail prices of medium-sized Bangus, Tilapia and Galunggong is currently at Php160.00/kg, Php100.00/kg, and Php160.00/kg, respectively.</p>
