Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*The implementation of Closed Fishing Season for Sardines, Herrings (<i>Sardinella spp.</i>), and Mackerels (<i>Rastrilliger spp.</i>) in some parts of the Visayan Sea begun last November 15, 2019 in as stated in Fisheries Administrative Order No. 167-3 Series of 2013.</p> <p>*The supply of marine fishes, including local Galunggong "lalaki" (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>) remain low for the whole week. According to interviews during the actual price monitoring and feedback from the enumerator, there was no unloading of fresh marine fishes due to the low volume of catch caused by: (1) the occurrence of full moon last November 12, wherein the the bright moonlight caused the marine fishes to scatter, making them difficult to catch, and (2) the lean season for the said commodities, and (3) the implementation of the Closed Fishing Seasons for local Galunggong in the Northern part of Palawan and for Sardines, Herrings (<i>Sardinella spp.</i>), and Mackerels (<i>Rastrilliger spp.</i>) as mentioned above.</p> <p>*The observed low supply also caused an increase in the number of brokers/traders that sell frozen/imported fishery commodities at the Navotas Fish Port</p> <p>*On the other hand, there is an observed small decrement the wholesale price of Bangus, which according to brokers/traders, may be attributed to the (1) large supply available at the Navotas Fish Port, (2) low demand from the buying public, and the (3) the healthy market competition.</p> <p>*As for Tilapia, the price and supply of the said commodities remain stable this week due to the stable volume coming from major source areas (e.g., Batangas).</p>
