Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>The implementation of the three-month fishing ban for Sardines in some parts of the Zamboanga Sea per BFAR Administrative Circular (BAC) 255, Series of 2014, begun this week. The ban includes species belonging to the Clupeidae family (i.e., <i>Sardinella lemuru</i>, <i>Sardilla fimbriata</i>, and <i>Sardinella gibbosa</i>).</p> <p>*Based on the team's actual price monitoring, the supply of marine fishes remain low this week. According to interviews, this may be due to the low volume of catch caused by: (1) the lean season for the said commodities, (2) the heavy rains brought by typhoon "Tisoy", which pressed some fisherfolk to halt their fishing operations, and (2) the implementation of fishing bans for some marine fishes including local Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>) in the Northern part of Palawan (per JAO No. 01 series of 2015), for Sardines, Herrings (<i>Sardinella spp.</i>), and Mackerels (<i>Rastrilliger spp.</i>) in some parts of the Visayan (per Fisheries Administrative Order No. 167-3 Series of 2013), and the aforementioned fishing ban of Sardines in some parts of Zamboanga Sea (per BFAR Administrative Circular 255).</p> <p>*The low supply was backed up by the observation of the enumerator that only one fishing vessel for marine fishes unloaded during the actual price monitoring activities this week. It was also confirmed during actual price monitoring activity that there is no supply of local Galunggong "lalaki" while majority of the available marine fishes are being sold in mixed species (e.g., <i>Selar crumenophthalmus</i>, <i>Decapterus spp.</i>, <i>Sardinella spp.</i>, etc.).</p> <p>*The low supply of fresh marine fishes also caused a higher demand for frozen/imported fishery commodities, which urged some brokers/trader at the Navotas Fish Port to increase their selling price. However, it was observed that the supply of frozen/imported fishery commodities also decreased, possibly contributing to its relatively higher price.</p> <p>*Majority of the available frozen/imported fishery commodities are Squids and Salmon Head.</p> <p>*Meanwhile, there is an observed small increment in the wholesale price of Tilapia due to the decrease in the supply unloaded on the fish port.</p> <p>*As for Bangus, brokers/traders noted that the price and supply of the commodity are stable. However, some vendors opted to increase their selling price due to the expected increase in the demand of fishery commodity brought by the nearing of Christmas holidays.</p> <p>*In addition, the low supply of marine commodities/capture fishes resulted to an increase in the demand of aquaculture commodities (e.g., Bangus and Tilapia.)</p>
