Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*DA-BFAR has lifted the closed season for Galunggong in Northeastern Palawan, with resumption of commercial fishing activities starting Feb. 1, 2019. (Source: Press Release by BFAR RFO-4B, dated 31 Jan. 2019).</p> <p>*It was observed during the actual price monitoring that despite the lifting of the closed season last Jan 31, most of the market stalls sell only frozen Galunggong and only a few stalls sell local GG.</p> <p>*Despite the recent news on the Taal Lake fish kill on the last week of January 2019, the wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia remained at Php110.00/kg and Php 80.00/kg, respectively.</p> <p>*Generally, marine fish price is high at this time due to the cold weather for which the catch is usually low and difficult because fish tend to stay at the bottom of the ocean.</p>
