Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*It can be observed that the prevailing price of medium-sized Galunggong is relatively high this week. According to interviewed market vendors this might be due to the following factors; (1) the occurrence of full moon last March 21, where marine fishes are scattered resulting to lesser and difficult catch; and (2) most of the local Galunggong unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port are of higher quality (in terms of freshness and sizes)</p> <p>*As for frozen GG, the prevailing price remained low due to the abundance of supply of local GG.</p> <p>*The prevailing price of medium-sized Bangus and Tilapia remained low at this time. According to some interviewed market vendors, this might be due to the abundance in supply of the said commodities alongside the low demand from the customers (i.e., "matumal ang bentahan"). It was also derived during market interviews that some vendors are selling their Bangus at a very low price just to get back their capital</p> <p>*Generally, marine fish price is high at this time due to the occurrence of fullmoon for which the catch is usually low and difficult because fish are scattered.</p>
