Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*Based the actual price monitoring, according to market vendors, the supply of Bangus and Tilapia at the Navotas Fish Port are stable.</p> <p>*It was also observed that the supply of marine fishes including local Galunggung decreased this week due to the occurrence of full moon, where the catch is usually low and difficult because marine fishes are scattered.</p> <p>*Some traders/brokers were also observed to be selling their supply of small-sized Bangus at a higher price compared to medium and large-sized due to the higher demand for small-sized as compared to medium and large-sized, as per interviewed market vendors.</p> <p>*It was also noted the demand of the three commodities is still low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan) which might contribute to the relatively low prices of the top fishery commodities.</p>
