Remarks/Market Observations:	<p><b>*It was observed during the team's actual price monitoring last July 29 that a large volume of large-sized local Galunggong alongside other marine fishery commodities such as Yellow fin tuna (<i>Thunnus albacares</i>) and Skipjack (<i>Katsuwonus pelamis</i>) were unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port. However, the supply of marine fishes decreased again in the monitoring on August 1 due to the rainy weather brought by a low pressure area. The unruly weather caused some fisherfolk to halt their fishing operations resulting to a low unloading at the fish port. In addition, it was derived from market interviews that the low volume of catch this week may also be attributed to the upcoming lean season for marine fish commodities.</b></p> <p><b>*The low supply of local Galunggong also caused an increase the number of brokers/traders that sell frozen/imported Galunggong at the Navotas Fish Port.</b></p> <p><b>*As for Tilapia, some brokers/traders noted that the price of the said commodity has a small increment due to a lesser supply at the Navotas Fish Port.</b></p> <p><b>*Per interview with market vendors, the supply of Bangus remained stable.</b></p> <p><b>*Some traders/brokers were observed to be selling their supply of small-sized Bangus at a higher price compared to medium and large-sized due to the higher demand for small-sized as compared to the other sizes.</b></p> <p><b>*The demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan) which might contribute to the relatively lower prices of the top fishery commodities.</b></p>
