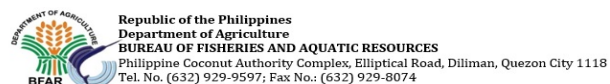

Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*It was observed during the team's actual price monitoring this week (August 5-9, 2019) that the supply of marine fishes, including local Galunggong, decreased due to the rainy weather brought by the tropical storm "Hanna." The weather disturbance has pressed some fisherfolk to suspend their fishing operations, resulting to a low unloading at the Navotas Fish Port. As a result of the low supply and to accomodate the demand for the said commodities, the number of brokers/traders that sell frozen or imported marine fishery commodities, including Galunggong, at the fish port increased.</p> <p>*The supply of Bangus and Tilapia remaned stable. However, there were feedback from some brokers/traders that there is a small increment in the price of Tilapia due to the lesser supply from Batangas, which is one of the major sources of the said commodity.</p> <p>*Some traders/brokers were observed to be selling their supply of small-sized Bangus at a higher price compared to medium and large-sized due to the higher demand for small-sized as compared to the other sizes.</p> <p>*The demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan) which might contribute to the relatively lower prices of the top fishery commodities.</p>
