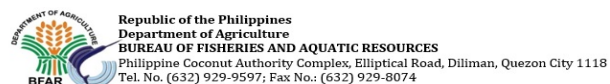

Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*Based on information gathered from the team's actual price monitoring, the supply of marine fishes, including local Galunggong, remain low this week (August 12-16) due to the heavy rain and recurring strong winds brought by Southwest Monsoon ("Habagat") which hindered fisherfolk from continuing their fishing operations, resulting to a low volume of catch and unloading at the Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>*The demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumang bentahan) which might contribute to the relatively lower prices of the top fishery commodities.</p> <p>*There is an observed increase in the number of brokers/traders that sell frozen/ imported fishery commodities, including Galunggong, as a response to the high demand and the low supply. There was also a large volume of unloading of frozen commodities at the Navotas Fish Port this week.</p> <p>*As for Tilapia, market brokers/traders noted that the supply of the said commodity decreased due to the lesser volume coming from Batangas which is one of its major source area.</p> <p>*The price of local Galunggong and Tilapia had a small increment among some of the brokers/traders at the Navotas Fish Port due to the low supply of the two commodities. Meanwhile, the price and supply of Bangus remain stable at Navotas Fish Port.</p> <p>*Some traders/brokers were observed to be selling their supply of small-sized Bangus at a higher price compared to medium and large-sized due to the higher demand for small-sized as compared to the other sizes.</p>
