Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*Based on the team's actual price monitoring at the Navotas Fish Port, the supply of marine fishes, including local Galunggong, remain low this week (August 19-23) due to the rainy weather and recurring strong winds brought by Southwest Monsoon ("Habagat") which hindered fisherfolk from continuing their fishing operations, as well as the occurrence of full moon which caused fishes to scatter. Per market interviews, both of these reasons contributed to the low volume of catch.</p> <p>*Meanwhile, the supply of Tilapia decreased due to a lesser volume of supply coming from Batangas which is one of the commodity's major source areas. Some brokers were also noted to be selling their Tilapia at a higher price due to the lesser supply.</p> <p>*As for Bangus, the supply remained stable for the whole week.</p> <p>*Some traders/brokers were observed to be selling their supply of small-sized Bangus at a higher price compared to medium and large-sized due to the higher demand for small-sized as compared to the other sizes.</p> <p>*The demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan) which might contribute to the relatively lower prices of the top fishery commodities.</p> <p>*There is an observed increase in the number of brokers/traders that sell frozen/ imported fishery commodities, including Galunggong, as a response to the high demand and the low supply. There was also a large volume of unloading of frozen commodities at the Navotas Fish Port this week.</p>
