Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>*It was observed during the team's actual price monitoring that only a small volume of marine fishes, including local Galunggong, was unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port due to the rainy weather and strong winds brought by Typhoon "Liwayway" which caused some fisherfolk to halt their fishing operations. It was also observed that majority of the available local Galunggong being sold at the said fish port are mixed with other marine commodities such as <i>Decapterus sp.</i>, <i>Sardinella sp.</i>, <i>Rastrilliger sp.</i>, among others.</p> <p>*The number of brokers/traders selling frozen/imported fishery commodities remain high due to the lesser supply of marine fishes.</p> <p>*As for Bangus, the supply of the said commodity decreased on the last week of August until the first week of September due lesser unloading from some major sources such as Pangasinan and Bulacan. It was also derived from interviews that some supply of Bangus are not yet ready for harvest due to its smaller size.</p> <p>*The low supply of Bangus and local Galunggong had an observed increase in the commodities' respective prevailing prices.</p> <p>*It was noted that some brokers/traders are selling Tilapia at a higher price despite the stable supply of the said commodity.</p> <p>*The demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan) which might contribute to lower prices of the top fishery commodities.</p>
