Remarks/Market Observations:		<p>*The supply of marine fishery commodity, including local Galunggong, remain low at the Navotas Fish Port this week due to the recurring heavy rain and strong winds brought about by Southwest monsoon ("Habagat") which interrupted fishing operations, resulting to a lesser volume of unloading at the fish port. Per traders and brokers, majority of the local Galunggong unloaded at the fish port are large-sized and some are being sold mixed with other marine commodities such as but not limited to <i>Decapterus sp.</i>, <i>Sardinella sp.</i>, <i>Rastrilliger sp.</i>,</p> <p>*The continuous low supply of marine fishes has urged a number of brokers/traders to sell frozen/imported fishery commodities.</p> <p>*As for Bangus, the supply of the said commodity continue to be low due to the lesser supply coming from Pangasinan and Bulacan, both of which are major source areas of the commodity. Based on interviews, the low supply can also be attributed to the postponed harvesting of producers in an effort to increase the size and value of their Bangus.</p> <p>*The prevailing prices of Bangus and local Galunggong are relatively higher this week due to low supply.</p> <p>* It was observed that some brokers/traders are selling their supply of Tilapia at a higher price despite the observed stable supply of the said commodity.</p> <p>*Generally, the demand for fishery commodities remain low (i.e., matumal ang bentahan). However, there are some recorded feedback that the demand for Bangus increased this week due to the recent issue on the "African Swine Fever."</p>
