Remarks/Market Observations:			<p>The following observations were observed/gathered during the team's actual price monitoring this week (September 16-20):</p> <p>*The supply of seaweeds and marine fishes, including local Galunggong, are low in the majority of the monitored retail markets. Per market vendors, this may be attributed to: (1) the recurring heavy rain and strong winds brought about by tropical depression "Marlyn", and "Nimfa", which hindered fisherfolk in continuing their fishing operations; (2) lower supply bought by retailers due to the low demand and the increase in their respective suppliers' wholesale price.</p> <p>*The low supply of local Galunggong urged some retail vendors to sell frozen/imported Galunggong, and for some wholesalers to increase their selling price.</p> <p>*The low demand for fishery commodities also caused retailers to lower their prices (i.e., bagsak presyo) to get back their capital and for some to totally close their stalls due to continuous losses.</p> <p>*There is an observed abundance of Galunggong "Babae" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>) and "Balsa" (<i>Decapterus russelli</i>) in the monitored markets.</p> <p>*The current prevailing retail prices of medium-sized Bangus, Tilapia and Galunggong are Php140.00/kg &amp; Php160.00/kg, and Php180.00/kg, respectively.</p> <p>*The supply of Bangus and Tilapia are stable in the majority of the monitored retail markets. However, it was noted that some wholesalers are selling their supply of the said commodities at a higher price despite the stable supply.</p> <p>*It was also observed that the wholesale price of fishery commodities is higher as compared to last July and August. Per interviews with market vendors, this might be attributed to the nearing of the Christmas holidays.</p> <p>*Some markets vendors are selling live Tilapia at Php20.00/kg higher than fresh dead Tilapia.</p> <p>*Bangus, Tilapia, and local Galunggong are being sold in mixed sizes in some of the monitored retail markets.</p> <p>*The current prevailing retail prices of medium-sized Bangus, Tilapia and Galunggong are Php140.00/kg &amp; Php160.00/kg, and Php180.00/kg, respectively.</p> <p>*It was noted that the price of some high-value marine fishes such as Yellow fin (<i>Thunnus albacares</i>) increased due to limited supply.</p> <p>*Some vendors have warned of a possible further increase in the price of fishery commodities due to the nearing of Christmas holidays.</p>
