Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>The following observations were observed/gathered during the team's actual price monitoring this week (September 16-20):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *There is only a small volume of unloading of marine fishes, including local Galunggong, at the Navotas Fish Port. According to interviews, this might be attributed to the recurring heavy rain and strong winds, which interrupted fishing operations resulting in lesser unloading. The lean season for marine fishes, particularly local Galunggong, might have also contributed to the low volume of catch. Based on actual price monitoring, majority of the available local Galunggong are large-sized and are being sold mixed with other marine commodities such as, but not limited to, <i>Decapterus sp.</i>, <i>Sardinella sp.</i>, *The number of brokers/traders that sell frozen/imported fishery commodities remain high due to the low supply of marine fishes. *The price of Bangus remains high due to the lesser supply unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port and the increased in its demand due to the recent issue on the African Swine Fever. It was also noted that large-sized Bangus is more preferred by buying public than the medium-sized. *As for Tilapia, the supply of the said commodity remain stable for the whole week. However, some brokers/traders are observed to be selling their supply of Tilapia at a higher price. *Per dialogue with brokers/traders, the nearing of the Christmas holiday might have contributed to the increase in the price of fishery commodities.
