Remarks/Market Observations:	<p>*Based on the team's actual price monitoring, the prevailing wholesale price of Bangus, especially the large-sized, remain high this week due to (1) the higher demand for Bangus relative to the recent issue on the "African Swine Fever" (ASF) and (2) the decrease in the supply coming from major source areas such as Pangasinan. The supply was reported to have increased on September 27; however, the price remained high.</p> <p>*There is an abundant supply of large-sized local Galunggong "lalaki" (<i>Decapterus macrosoma</i>), and "balsa" (<i>Decapterus macarellus</i>) unloaded at the Navotas Fish Port last September 23. The supply of the above-mentioned commodities, alongside other marine fishes, decreased again during the September 27 monitoring activity. The commodities were also observed to be sold mixed with other marine commodities such as, but not limited to, <i>Sardinella lemuru</i>, <i>Auxis spp.</i>, <i>Rastilliger sp.</i>. This observation may have caused the relatively lower price of local Galunggong on September 27.</p> <p>*A large number of brokers/traders are observed to be selling frozen/imported fishery commodities including Galunggong (<i>Decapterus spp.</i>).</p> <p>*The supply of Tilapia remain stable this week. It can be derived from the Bureau's price monitoring data that the price is relatively higher at this time as compared to last July.</p> <p>*Per interview with brokers/traders, the nearing of the Christmas holiday might have contributed to the increase in the price of fishery commodities.</p>
