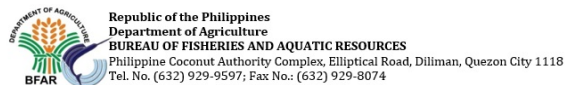

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- Local-fresh galunggong still has minimal availability at the monitored wholesale market as the rainy weather condition, Habagat, and lean fishing season continue to bring very low volume of marine catch. Further, only one fishing vessel unloaded local-fresh galunggong at Navotas Fish Port on the early part of the week which are reportedly of high quality, resulting to the high wholesale price of local-fresh galunggong (Php188.00/kg). The wholesale price then eventually decreased in the last part of the week at Php118.00/kg as more fishing vessel unloaded at Navotas Fish Port.
- Supply for Bangus and Tilapia continue to have a stable unloadings at Navotas Fish Port which resulted to a stable wholesale price.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follows:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong – Palawan
- According to Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA), some importers were able to bargain with the Authority to sell their remaining stocks of imported galunggong from those allowed under Fisheries Administrative Order No. 259, S. 2018 at the fish port; hence, the imported commodity was available at Navotas Fish Port on the late part of the week at Php120.00/kg.
- Safety measures such as but not limited to wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection are continuously implemented at the monitored markets as precaution against the increasing number of COVID-19 cases.
- Data gathering at Navotas Fish Port is conducted through phone calls or SMS in coordination with market masters and administrators, vendors, and stall holders in view of the Bureau's temporary suspension of physical monitoring activities beginning July 21 Physical monitoring will resume once safety of enumerators in the monitored wet markets are ascertained.
