**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Supplies of Bangus and Tilapia at Navotas Fish Port continue to be stable as there continues to be supplies from major source areas.
- Unloading of Local Galunggong and other marine commodities continue to be low, which may be attributed to the lean fishing season and bad weather conditions brought by Typhoon "Ofel" which hampered most of the fishing operations.
- Stocks of imported galunggong continue to be available at Navotas Fish Port.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are sourced mainly from the following areas:  
 Commodity Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port)  
 Bangus Pangasinan  
 Tilapia Batangas  
 Local Galunggong Palawan
- In line with the General Community Quarantine (GCQ) protocols, same precautionary management measures (e.g wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection) as well as regular clean-up and disinfection are being implemented by Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers.
