**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel:

- Volume of Local-Fresh Galunggong unloaded were greatly affected by (1) hampered fishing and transport operations due to heavy rainfalls and storm surge brought by *Hanging Amihan* and Typhoon Quinta, and (2) occurrence of full moon or "Hunter's Moon."
- Tilapia and Bangus from Bulacan and Batangas were not available at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) as flash floods or landslides brought by the Typhoon Quinta impeded harvest and transport of aquacultured commodities, especially those from CALABARZON and MIMAROPA.
- Imported-frozen Galunggong, on the other hand, are still observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) at a relatively high wholesale price.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are sourced mainly from the following areas:

 Local-Fresh Galunggong      NA
- Some precautionary management measures (e.g wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection) as well as regular clean-up and disinfection are being implemented by Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers.
