**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnels this week:

- Sufficient displays of Bangus and Tilapia were observed at Navotas Fish Port this week.
- However, no Local-fresh Galunggong was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) as a result of: (a) heavy rains brought by Super Typhoon Rolly, which greatly affected southern part of Luzon; (b) Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for pelagic fishes, including galunggong, in Northeastern Palawan from Nov. 1, 2020 to Feb. 15, 2021 (Source: Philippines News Agency. *Cudis, C. 13 Oct 2020, retrieved from: https://www.pna.gov.ph/articles/1118394*); and (c) occurrence of full moon or "Hunter's Moon" on October 31, 2020.
- For Imported-frozen Galunggong, limited volumes of the commodity were noted at the fish port.
- Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are sourced mainly from the following areas:  
 Commodity Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port)  
 Bangus Pangasinan  
 Tilapia Batangas  
 Local-fresh Galunggong NA
- Same precautionary management measures (e.g., wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection) as well as regular clean-up and disinfection are being implemented by Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to ensure the safety of vendors and buyers against COVID-19.
