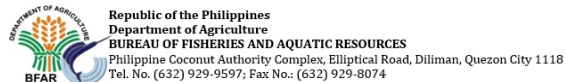

Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

- Amid the on-going Closed Fishing Season for pelagic fish species in Northeastern Palawan, supply of Local-Fresh Galunggong from Balabac, Southern Palawan was observed at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) on Nov. 9 priced at Php170.00/kg. However, no supply of local galunggong were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port from Nov. 11-14 due to the effects of Typhoon Ulysses on fishing and transport operations.
- No Imported-Frozen Galunggong was available at the fish port this week.
- Adequate volumes of Bangus and Tilapia were unloaded at Navotas Fish Port, resulting to stable wholesale prices of the commodities.
- Major source areas of the top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port are as follow:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local galunggong – NA
- Precautionary safety measures such as but not limited to wearing of face masks and face shields, and mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection are still being implemented by the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) to safeguard consumers and vendors against COVID-19. Traders are also required to wear white shirts and boots inside the Navotas Fish Port Complex.
- The heavy rains and strong winds brought by Super Typhoon Ulysses on Nov. 8-13 has greatly affected the supply situation of the top fishery commodities from major source areas
