<b>Remarks/Market Observations:</b>		The following observations were gathered from market personnel: 1. At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), only small-sized Local-Fresh Galunggong Babae were unloaded as fishing operations continue to be hampered by the Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for pelagic fishes in Northern Palawan, which is a major source area of Galunggong. Consequently, unloaded supplies of Local-Fresh Galunggong at the fish port were sourced from South Palawan. 2. Imported-frozen Galunggong was noted in small volumes at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). Still, the commodity serves as an alternative commodity to the local variant amid the latter's high selling price and limited availability. 3. Meanwhile, sufficient volumes of Bangus were noted at the fish port. Tilapia, on the other hand, was observed to have fluctuating supplies as volumes unloaded were influenced by the harvest schedule of tilapia producers, taking into consideration the differences in culture period. 4. Top fishery commodities at Navotas Fish Port were sourced mainly from the following areas: Commodity Wholesale (Navotas Fish Port) Bangus Pangasinan Tilapia Batangas Local Galunggong Southern Palawan 5. Vendors still experience "mahinang bentahan" or low demand of fishery commodities. Nonetheless, precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 are still continuously being observed in the monitored markets to safeguard consumers and vendors.
