The following observations were gathered from market personnel and vendors this week:

1. Supply and prices of Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan, alongside other marine commodities, continue to fluctuate as fishing operations continue to be hampered by the following:

- (a) Closed Fishing Season for pelagic fishes (including galunggong) in Northern Palawan;
- (b) CFS for Sardines, Herrings, and Mackerels in Northern Palawan;
- (c) Bright light brought by the occurrence of full moon or "Beaver Moon" on November 30; and
- (d) Occurrence of *Habagat* or Northeast Monsoon;

2. Imported-frozen Galunggong, on the other hand, was available in selected retail markets (i.e., Commonwealth, Tandang Sora, Mega-Q, Farmers, Balintawak, and Munoz Markets) this week, despite its limited availability at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale). According to vendors, the available displays of the imported commodity on Dec. 4 were remaining unsold supplies from previous market day and weekend.

3. For Bangus, some monitored retail markets (i.e., Balintawak, Munoz, Commonwealth) increased their selling price amid the approaching holidays. However, the increments in the retail markets had no impact on the prevailing price retail price, which remained at Php160.00/kg.

4. Tilapia supplies also remain stable in the monitored retail markets at a prevailing price of Php120.00/kg.

5. Top fishery commodities in the 11 monitored retail markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:

- a. Bangus - Bulacan
- b. Tilapia - Batangas
- c. Local Galunggong - Lucena, Quezon

6. *Matumal na bentahan* continues to be apparent in the monitored wholesale and retail markets. As a result, some vendors adjusted their volumes for selling to ensure that all supplies are sold out by the end of the day, or are operating on a half-day basis to avoid profit loss.

7. Nonetheless, precautionary management measures against COVID-19 are implemented in the monitored retail markets such as wearing of face masks and face shields, mandatory temperature checks and hand disinfection, and limiting of number of buyers entering the markets.

8. Effective November 26, new set of Suggested Retail Prices (SRP) for Bangus, Tilapia, Imported-frozen Galunggong, and Alumahan were issued by the Department of Agriculture (DA) at Php160.00/kg, Php120.00/kg, Php140.00/kg, and Php250.00/kg, respectively.
