Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and administrators:

- At Navotas Fish Port (wholesale), unloadings of marine fishery commodities, particularly Local-Fresh Galunggong and Alumahan, remain unstable due to Closed Fishing Season for pelagic fishes in Northeastern Palawan and Visayan Sea. In addition, the cold weather condition brought about by Northeast Monsoon also causes volume catch as it drives fishes to the bottom of the ocean, making them more inaccessible.
- Supplies and wholesale prices of Bangus and Tilapia, however, was stable and sufficient for the whole week.
- As a substitute commodity to Local-Fresh Galunggong, Imported-frozen Galunggong was available at Navotas Fish Port (wholesale) at a relatively high price amid the shift in demand due to the unavailability of its local variant.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
 - Local Galunggong - Southern Palawan
 - Alumahan - Zamboanga
- The Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) continues the strict implementation of precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 are continuously being implemented at Navotas Fish Port to safeguard its consumers and vendors.
