Remarks/Market Observations:

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and administrators:

- Supplies of fresh marine commodities, such as Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan, continue to be volatile amid the implementation of the ongoing Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for pelagic fishes in Northeastern Palawan and Visayan Sea which are major fishing grounds of the said commodities. In addition, the cold weather brought by Northeast Monsoon also influenced the low volume of catch as it drives fishes to the bottom of the ocean, making them harder to catch.
- Meanwhile, supplies and prices of Bangus and Tilapia remain sufficient despite the higher demand due to the approaching holiday season.
- Top fishery commodities in the monitored markets are sourced mainly from the following areas:
 - Bangus - Pangasinan
 - Tilapia - Batangas
- Strict implementation of precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 (i.e., wearing of face masks & face shields, wearing of white boots & white shirts, and mandatory temperature checks and hand sanitation) are continuously being implemented by Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA) at Navotas Fish Port.
