**Remarks/Market Observations:**

The following observations were gathered from market personnel and administrators:

- At Navotas Fish Port, no Local-fresh Galunggong and Alumahan were unloaded. The volatile unavailability of fresh marine commodities may be attributed to:
  - two (2) LPAs in Palawan & Quezon on Sunday;
  - cold weather condition brought by Northeast Monsoon or Amihan;
  - Closed Fishing Season (CFS) for pelagic fishes in Northeastern Palawan and Visayan Sea, which are major fishing grounds for Galunggong and Alumahan
- Meanwhile, supplies of Bangus and Tilapia at Navotas Fish Port continue to be sufficient. However, prices are noted to be relatively higher due to the higher demand brought by the holiday season.
- Top fishery commodities at the fish port are sourced mainly from the following areas:
  - Bangus - Pangasinan
  - Tilapia - Batangas
  - Imported galunggong - China, Vietnam
- Continuous implementation of precautionary safety measures against COVID-19 is in place at Navotas Fish Port as part of the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA)'s measures to avoid further spread of the virus.
